It was a pleasure speaking with you this afternoon...as we discussed, here are some 'bullets' to share with your Caltrans team regarding this project on Highway 70 from Bucks Creek [REDACTED] PG&E will be undergrounding a vast majority of our electric facilities as part of our Wildfire Safety Enhancements for this area and we are eager to partner with Caltrans and other Agencies to ensure a successful project delivery.

As discussed, at this time we only have a project limit map and we are currently working on surveying the area so we can create a base map to superimpose the design of the project and as soon as we have that information we can provide to you and your Caltrans team. We appreciate you facilitating the on-site meeting and I think that it would be beneficial to have someone from your Division of Permits, Design, Environmental and Maintenance and Traffic Operations in attendance, if available.
