- Approval to continue the DSDD Pilot Projects (3 projects, 5 miles)
- Approval to continue with the 3 in-flight PSPS mitigation projects (3 projects, 3.6 miles)
- Approval to start scoping 133 circuits in top tier for PSPS Mitigation, including the 13 community impact projects (10-15 miles); scope approval to include alternatives to system hardening
- Approval to continue the Remote Grid projects (4 projects, 5.7 miles)
- Approval to continue the ECOP projects just below the top 20% cutoff (3 projects, 6.9 miles)
