- Underground – PSPS project [REDACTED] & CWSP project [REDACTED]
 - Most likely will break ground early next year. It *may* be possible to start work this year, but will depend on many factors. For external conversations, share that work will most likely be done by

next year's PSPS season, not this upcoming PSPS season.

- By end of May, *will* most likely have an estimate on where to place the various equipment

PM [REDACTED] requires an easement from the tribe prior to design taking place....this may be why there are markings on the ground/street since we are developing 'base-maps' for both this project and [REDACTED] which are both scoped to place the current OH system underground.

You can also see in the attached email, where I am working with 'land acquisition agent', [REDACTED] to assist in helping the project gain the needed easements on the tribal land.
