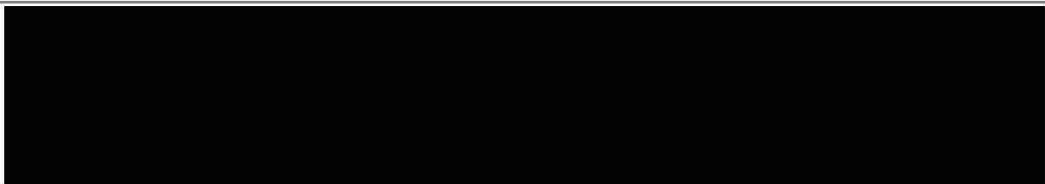

**Subject:** Dixie Fire talking points

Our noon talking points. On the next round I'll develop something specific to the 50,000 question.

- The safety of our customers and communities is PG&E primary responsibility.
- PG&E continues to monitor the Dixie Fire, and we have crews on-site to support first-responders.
- Firefighters requested a distribution line be de-energized last night for firefighter safety.
- Several transmission lines are now de-energized. As of 11:30 a.m., approximately 10,000 PGE customers in Plumas County are without power. We are investigating restoration options.
- It's near the footprint of the Camp Fire.
