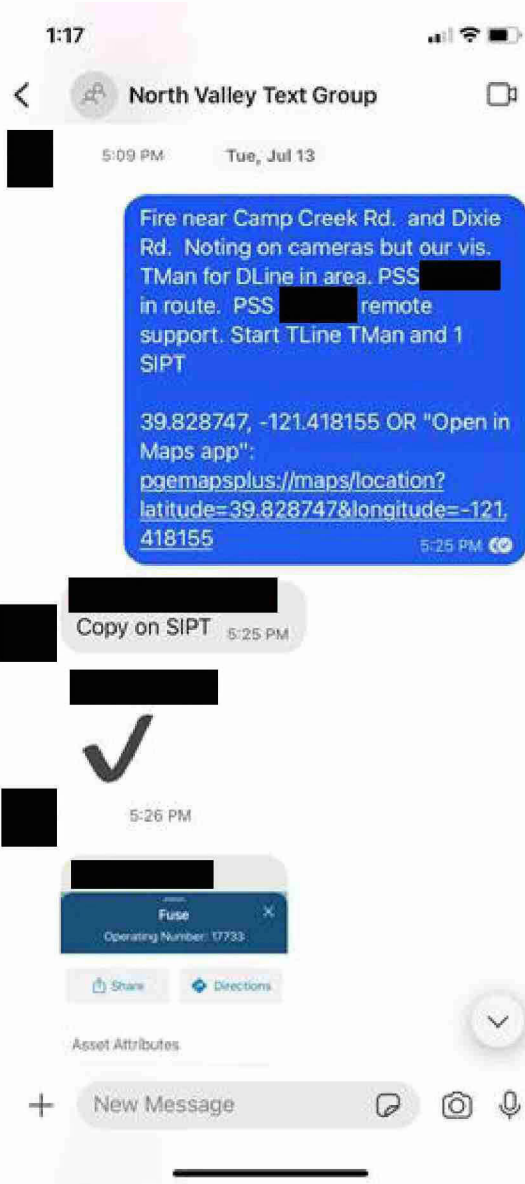

Dixie Fire update. Fire is 900 acres burning still under down canyon winds in the bottom of canyon along Camp Creek Rd and up slope toward the Caribou Table 230kV at the ridge top U line/ Concow Rd. Fire is beginning to heat up with increased activity. Very steep and inaccessible terrain. Expect Fire to continue up slope and transition from down canyon in the drainage to up canyon soon with daily wind transition. I've been in contact with [REDACTED] SIPT [REDACTED] and E211 & E213 pre treating Bucks Creek 1101 section along Hwy 70 from Rock Creek east and then they will pre treat Big Bend 1101 later today/tomorrow from Flea Mtn. back west to Concow. PSS [REDACTED] at scene as AREP, PSS [REDACTED] support. If you cannot reach me try SIPT [REDACTED] as he is my back up at the fire due to poor communications. PSS [REDACTED] has GIS working on asset map with fire perimeter.

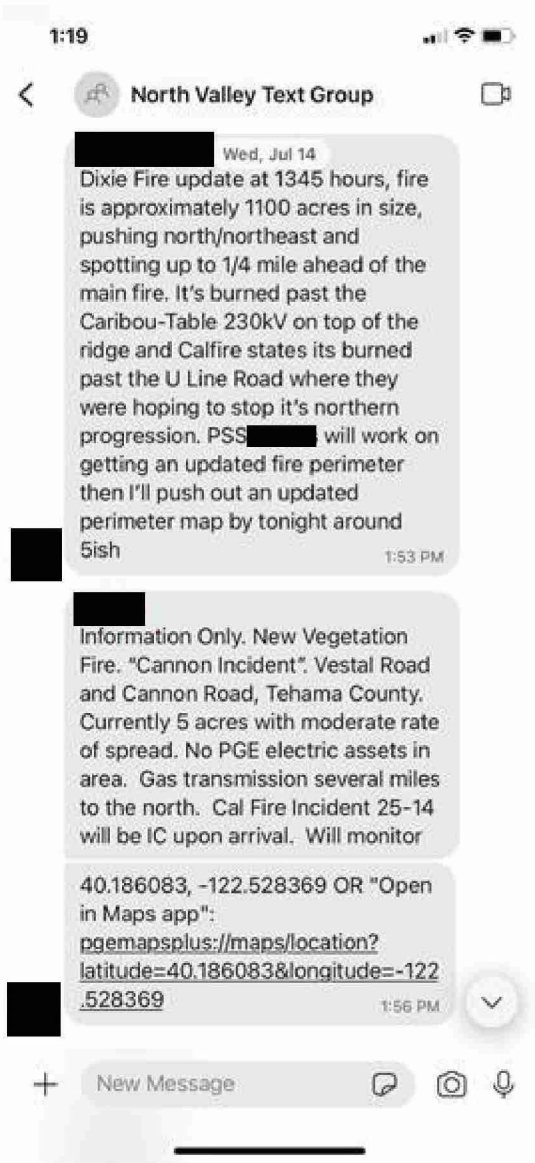

Dixie Fire update at 1345 hours, fire is approximately 1100 acres in size, pushing north/northeast and spotting up to 1/4 mile ahead of the main fire. It's burned past the Caribou-Table 230kV on top of the ridge and Calfire states its burned past the U Line Road where they were hoping to stop it's northern progression. PSS will work on getting an updated fire perimeter
