Got your message. Here's what I have so far.

- The safety of our customers and communities is PG&E primary responsibility.
- PG&E continues to monitor the Dixie Fire in Plumas County, and we have crews on-site to support first-responders.
- Several transmission lines are now de-energized. As of 11:30 a.m., approximately 10,000 PGE customers in Plumas County are without power. We are investigating restoration options.
- The fire is near the footprint of the Camp Fire.
