PG&E's now-de-energized Caribou-Palermo transmission runs parallel to the two other lines in the area (Feather River canyon area east of Pulga). Can you please affirm the names of the two other lines and explain whether they are currently energized/operational?</p> <p>--Cal Fire said that investigators have not determined how the fire began. At this time, does PG&E have any comment as to whether its transmission lines may have been involved?</p> <p>--Is PG&E investigating or reviewing its transmission lines in relation to the Dixie Fire? Is there any information as to whether those lines experienced any unusual events or malfunctions recently?</p>
