Weather, [REDACTED]: Temp 77, Humidity 35, Wind gusts 19 mph on nearest weather station. Fire progressing northward. No RFWs or Fire Weather Watches and no adverse weather in forecast. Just typical hot and dry California weather. Fire Index R4 trending down to R3 due to cooler temperatures. Wind goes up canyon during the day, down canyon at night.

HAWC, [REDACTED]: 1,100 acres. Pushing N/NE. Spotting a half mile ahead. Burning away from Concow. SIPT have done pre-treatment on Buck Creek circuit and will do Big Bend before tonight. Fire seems to be holding in place. (Note: The team is in the new HAWC Next today, Jim reports out.)

IC, [REDACTED]: EOC opening based on location, sensitivities.

[REDACTED] runs a fire-spread model, increasing the wind speed, and it shows that it'll really just continue to spread up into the unoccupied wildland. Really no model shows impact to people or houses. [REDACTED] notes that this is far from a PSPS in October event with Diablo winds.
