For some reason I am unable to access the summary file via VPN. However, here is the status for the ELISA assays:

The fertility assays Estradiol, HcG, LH, FSH from the list are complete. We had an issue with one of the Genway antibodies for the LH assay being discontinued. We do have sufficient inventory of the original pair and an alternate antibody has been identified and optimization is being completed.

Other assays that are complete are CRP and Rubella antibody.

Development is ongoing on TSH, PSA, Troponin T, HbS Ag, Ferritin.

Vitamin B-12 & Vitamin D are in the reagent procurement stages with information being gathered from various vendors (Dojindo, Pierce, etc) on making the vitamin-Alkaline phosphatase conjugates since both will be competitive assays. Commercially available kits have been tested in-house.

Folic acid has been assigned to Danielle (Priti's group) and Winny (Andrea's group) has been assigned CK-MB.

Hope this helps.
