<b>Description:</b>

<b>What are the key Features that are highlighted in this piece?</b>
The <b>ESP Tool Kit</b> is a multimedia CD-ROM focusing on practical, educational resources and tools emphasizing the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Emerging Solutions in Pain</b> website as a resource for all of the <b>ESP</b> initiatives, including links to the <b>Tool Kit</b>, case studies (HCP is able to download tools), CE programs, a calendar of events and clinical expert commentary</li> <li>• Specific educational events in the <b>ESP</b> initiative, including a series of accredited regional meetings known as the RESPECT series, Symposia at major medical meetings and congresses and the <b>ESP</b> Meet the Experts Exhibit Booth</li> </ul>
