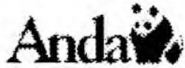

I'm not familiar with Deanne's project. What I think she's doing is flagging suspicious orders in the order entry process. For Andanet orders, testing is easy. She can grab a large batch of data from a previous day and run them through the system. Manually keyed orders are a different story, though. They need to actually be keyed in which obviously isn't practical for a whole days worth of data. The normal procedure would be to just key in a large enough sample of orders covering a range of scenarios to feel comfortable with the change. I really don't know another way to test an online application.
